Appointed by and accountable to the Executive Commissioner and Chief Executive Officer of Scouts Canada, you'll be required to donate 20 to 24 hours per month (on average) to this position. A Council Commissioner may hold this position for no more than 3 consecutive years, each term being for one year as per By-Law, Policies and Procedures.

Working closely with the Council Executive Director and the Council Youth Commissioner you will help plan and manage the affairs of your geographic Council and be the principle contact for your Council regarding program management, membership development and ensuring a safe environment for youth to learn and develop.

Above all, you'll play a key role in ensuring your Council Action Plan is consistent with Scouts Canada's Action Plan (www.scoutingnow.org) and Strategic Directions. As the Council Commissioner you will represent your Council at both National and Atlantic Canada meetings and conferences held 2-3 times per year.

Your upbeat, positive attitude will encourage a climate favourable for growth of Canada's best youth movement. You'll support the promotion of all seven programs currently offered for youth aged 5 – 26. With a keen eye for great leaders who think like you, you'll selectively recruit, orient and appoint Area Commissioners and other volunteers for your Council Leadership Team.

As a member of the Executive Commissioner and Chief Executive Officer's team, you'll provide quarterly reports on the program status of the Council. You'll ensure an effective flow of accurate and timely information regarding all Scouting matters, including procedure and policy changes.

Qualifications

- Two or more years experience as a program volunteer.
- Completed Wood Badge Part II for one or more program sections.
- Committed to undertake further personal development related to the role of Council Commissioner, within one year.
- Effective interpersonal skills and an ability to motivate others.
- Modeled positive behaviours appropriate to Scouting.
- Registered as a member of Scouts Canada.
- Demonstrated knowledge of the Volunteer Recruitment and Development (VRAD) process.
